

Peak-Time Payback (PTP) Enphase Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Program Member Enrollment Experience Guide

The following link will initiate the process of enrolling your Enphase BESS for GVEC's PTP Program allowing you to be eligible for the Advance Payment rebate as well as ongoing incentives, as defined in the Program Terms and Conditions.



The below steps will serve as a guide to seamlessly walk you through the six step enrollment process.

1. Confirm eligibility by clicking the box to checkmark each of the five criterion listed.
2. Fill out customer account information¹ including your account number, account sub number, last name, email address and cell phone number / provider.
3. Indicate whether system was installed on or after July 1, 2024. If so, you will be asked to upload a copy of your invoice as proof upon clicking 'Next' at the bottom right of the screen.
4. The screen should now read 'Thank you for your information.' Now click 'Enroll Battery' at the bottom right of the screen. This will direct you to the Enphase Enlighten login page.
5. Once logged in with the appropriate credentials, the screen should look similar to the example provided below. Ensure that the appropriate SiteID is selected for the battery devices and click the blue 'Allow Access' button.
